

Title: The Future Triumph Of God's Children

Text: 1:17-21

Main Idea: God compares the future of His Children to the dreadful future reserved for those who come under His judgment.

Division Statements:

1. There shall be deliverance (v. 17a).

Note: A great place to give and in depth exegesis of פְּלִיטָה, a very important Hebrew word, especially in the Psalms.

2. There shall be righteousness (v. 17b).

“Holiness.”

3. There shall be security (v. 17c).

“... shall possess their possessions” - take possession of what is already rightfully there's as the children of God. The phrase speaks of certainty and stability.

4. There shall be victory (v. 18).

The fate of Esau's house here is both literal and emblematic of all the enemies of God and His people.

5. There shall be an inheritance (vv. 19-20).

Compare these verses with the third beatitude.

6. There shall be everlasting peace (v. 21).

This verse refers to the administration of Christ's millennial Kingdom and the eternal state, thereafter.
